Subject: State Police Commission Rule 13.33

Pursuant to the provisions of State Police Commission rule 2.10(a), the State Police Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, August 17, 2000 to consider repealing and reenacting State Police Commission Rule 13.33. The hearing will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room, Eleventh Floor, Wooddale Towers Building, 1885 Wooddale Boulevard, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

13.33 Referee Decisions or Actions; Rehearings.

(a) A Referee may make only decisions or rulings, and take action in an appeal which is interlocutory in nature. A Referee may not make any decision or take any action which disposes of the entire appeal or any portion thereof.

Other than evidentiary or procedural rulings made during a hearing, all decisions, orders or actions of a Referee shall be subject to review as provided in Rule 13.36.

(b) No rehearing shall be granted from a decision of the Commission or Referee.

Please review this proposal and furnish, in writing, by August 7, 2000, any comments which you consider pertinent. If you would like to appear before the Commission and present your comments orally, you are invited to do so. You must notify this office by August 7, 2000 of your intention to address the Commission, in order to be placed on the agenda.

Please post this General Circular prominently, so that all employees will receive notice of this hearing. If any special accommodations are needed, please notify us prior to the hearing date.
