Revision of State Police Commission Rule 3.1(o); Revision of State Police

Commission Rule 2.10(a) and (b); and Repeal of State Police Commission Rules

2.10(c), (d) and (e)

Due to the lack of a quorum of Members of the Commission present, the September 18, 1995 meeting was canceled. As a result, the State Police Commission will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 16, 1995, at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room, Eleventh Floor, Wooddale Towers Building, 1885 Wooddale Boulevard, Baton Rouge, Louisiana to consider revisions and repeal of the following State Police Commission Rules.

3.1 Duties of the Director.

It shall be the duty of the Director of Personnel

(o) To review and approve or disapprove all contracts entered into between the Office of State Police and all persons rendering personal services to or on behalf of the Office of State Police, which contracts shall, prior to the effective date of the contract, be submitted to the Director of the State Police Commission.

In the event that such contract(s) are disapproved, the Director shall state in the instrument of disapproval the position to which such services are or may be assigned.

2.10 Adoption, Amendment or Repeal of Rules; Emergency Rule Changes.

(a) Except as provided for herein in Rule 2.10(b), the adoption, amendment or repeal of

- any rule shall be approved by the Commission only upon thirty (30) days written notice and approval after a public hearing.
- (b) If the Commission finds that an imminent peril to the public health, safety or welfare or another emergency requires adoption of a rule change without compliance with Rule 2.10(a), the adoption, amendment or repeal of any rule may be approved by the Commission upon a statement of such record and without compliance with the provisions of Rule 2.10(a).
