Subject: State Police Commission Rules 2.1(a); and 7.9(a)2.a.

Pursuant to the provisions of State Folice Commission Rule 2.16(a), the State Police Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, November 15, 2001 to consider repealing and reenacting State Police Commission Rules 2.1(a); and 7.9(a)2.a. The hearing will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room, Eleventh Floor, Wooddale Towers Building, 1885 Wooddale Boulevard, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

- 2.1 Election of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman
 - (a) The members of the Commission shall meet and organize by electing one of its members Chairman and one of its members Vice-Chairman; provided that the member of the Commission elected by the classified state police officers of the state shall not be eligible for the office of either Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Commission. In case of a vacancy in either office, the Commission shall elect a replacement from among its members.

This change is necessary to allow the Commission to operate more effectively.

- 7.9 Promotional Examinations.
 - (a) The Director may conduct a competitive promotional examination for any vacant or prespectively vacant position, provided
 - 2. Admission to such examination shall be restricted to permanent employees who neet <u>or will meet</u>, <u>within the calendar year</u>, the qualifications stated in the class specifications for the position for which the promotional examination is announced. An employee currently rated unacceptable (i.e., "needs improvement" or "unsatisfactory" shall not be admitted to any competitive test.

This change is necessary to allow applicants who become eligible during the calendar year to take the promotional examination prior to actually being eligible for promotion.

You must notify this office by November 5, 2001 of your intention to address the Commission, in order to be placed on the agenda.
