Subject: State Police Commission Rule 8.8

Pursuant to the provisions of State Police Commission Rule 2.10(a), the State Police Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, December 20, 2001 to consider repealing and reenacting State Police Commission Rule 8.8. The hearing will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room, Eleventh Floor, Wooddale Towers Building, 1885 Wooddale Boulevard, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

8.8 Probationary Appointment.

When a vacancy in a position is filled by an original appointment of an eligible, such appointee shall serve a probationary period. The probationary period shall be from the date of appointment to the State Police service, and extending through twelve (12) months from the date of graduation from the State Police Training Academy. For employees who are non-competitively re-employed, such probationary period shall be twelve (12) months from the date of re-employment.

This rule change is proposed to bring Rule 8.8 into compliance with Rule 9.1(a).

Please review this proposal and furnish, in writing, by December 10, 2001, any comments which you consider pertinent. If you would like to appear before the Commission and present your comments orally, you are invited to do so. You must notify this office by December 10, 2001 of your intention to address the Commission, in order to be placed on the agenda.
